## **1. Agenda Approval for Open Session**

## **2. Status Reports**

### **- TAC**

No meeting since last LLC meeting. Further meetings not planned in the absence of contributions on Toll Free ENUM.

### **- Other industry groups**

Jay Carpenter – The SNAC is looking at Toll Free number dispute resolution. Their work may affect dispute resolution for ENUM Toll Free.

Tim Denton - No further developments in Canada.

### **- End-user trial Update**

Robert Schafer – The TPAC produced a draft trial report for the LLC. There was discussion between TPAC and LLC earlier this week about the draft. The LLC asked TPAC to refine some portions. A TPAC call will be scheduled in next couple of weeks to add details to some sections. The LLC and its counsel will then review for the report for release and delivery to the USG.

### **- TPAC report**

### **- Provider Trial Update**

Robert Schafer- Provider ENUM testing is complete. PETPAC members are focusing on compiling technical details of the trial results. End User Trial work has taken precedence. Results of trial will be documented.

### **3. Q&A**

Jim Baskin – The LLC reviewed the RIPE-NCC working group questions and submitted answers.

Hala Mowafy – Were there any surprising findings in the trial?

Jim Baskin - No. The LLC's is seeking to have report in mid August. Then the LLC needs USG feedback before moving forward with RFP.

Steve Lind – The LLC will also see if the report presents any technical issues to be resolved.

Andy Gallant - What are expectations re Provider ENUM? How does the LLC expect to assess industry interest in User ENUM as discussed on TPAC call yesterday?

Jim Baskin: Re User ENUM, the LLC needs not only USG input on steps needed for permanent delegation of e164.arpa but also needs to ensure sufficient interest from different industry segments to justify an RFP. As to how the LLC will determine this, the LLC still considering. Suggestions for assessing industry interest would be appreciated.

Robert Schafer – the industry's reaction of industry to USG feedback on report may be a part of this.

Andy Gallant - good idea to get views from USG and industry.

Jim Baskin re Provider ENUM and PETPAC, once the report is developed we expect the PETPAC would go into hibernation pending further developments. The LLC is still considering further steps for Provider ENUM.

Beth O'Donnell – What is the status of the registry for Provider ENUM?

Jim Baskin - The trial registry will not be used going forward as it is not scalable. The LLC would be happy to have further discussions with carriers interested in Provider ENUM.
