Status Reports

TAC

Nothing to report. The TAC has not met and has received no contributions.

Other industry groups

Richard Shockley summarized relevant activities at the recent IETF meeting. The ENUM WG continues to wind down. It is expected that the IANA registration procedures for ENUM services will go to WG last call. Most services types being proposed replicate TCAP capabilities. Comcast and NeuStar co-chaired the PEPPERMINT BOF. There were 200 people in attendance with about 25 interested in working the issues. A draft requirements I-D is expected before the

Philadelphia meeting. Verizon expressed interested in developing use cases. The WG should be chartered on or after the Philadelphia meeting.

End-user trial report update

Jim Baskin reiterated that the report has been transmitted to all 19 NANPA governments. No specific comments have been received. The LLC has been in contact with the USG . They are considering the report and the various issues and have indicated an interest in meeting with the LLC sometime during 1Q08.

Karen Mulberry asked if there will be any involvement with the TPAC members in the meeting. The LLC indicated that it is still very early in deciding any agenda and will consider inviting the TPAC to participate during the planning process.

LLC Initiatives

Robert Schafer indicated that there are new items on the home page of the LLC's Web site that provide specific updated information on the LLC's initiatives, particularly in the area of Provider ENUM.

Provider ENUM RFP

Steve Lind reiterated the December 3rd announcement that the LLC has released the Provider ENUM RFP. The text of the RFP (including the associated technical requirements) and the schedule of associated events are posted on the LLC's Web site. That schedule has been changed from the original one posted; interested parties should check the Web site frequently for any subsequent updates. Bidders' questions on the RFP may be submitted by email (to chair@enumllc.com) no later than January 15, 2008 and will be reviewed at the bidders' conference on January 23, 2008 in Richardson, TX.

Karen Mulberry asked if the answers to the questions will be posted on the Web site; the LLC indicated that it intended to do that. Richard Shockey thought that the timing of the RFP release could have been better with the upcoming holidays if it had been postponed until after the New Year.

Q&A

Jay Carpenter asked about anything new going on with end-user ENUM in any other countries. Richard Shockey indicated that the UK had awarded the operation of its registry for 4.4.e164.arpa to Nominet. He also indicated that Ofcom had issued an order changing its number portability mechanism that may impact ENUM in that country. The Dutch are looking at the same issues and thinking about adding URI's to that database.
