

Dear Chairman Baskin:

Thank you for your October 26, 2007 letter and report regarding Country Code 1 ENUM LLC's end-user ENUM trials. The U.S. Government continues to support industry led initiatives such as those demonstrated by the work on the ENUM protocol and we will continue to monitor the industry's progress regarding ENUM implementation within the United States. In the meantime, we will take under advisement your results and recommendations provided in the end-user ENUM trial report. As to your invitation that the U.S. Government host a public forum to address the future of end-user ENUM, we believe it is more appropriate for industry to schedule a public forum addressing end-user ENUM, if you believe one is needed. Such an approach would be consistent with our view that industry should continue its leadership role in determining the future of ENUM implementation within the United States.

Finally, we encourage industry to continue to supply the forward thinking that spurs the introduction of new innovative ideas, which improve our lives and form the foundation of a healthy growing economy. As always, we look forward to our continued collaboration on ENUM and other important work.
